BENEFIT	WHAT WE NEED	HOW IT WORKS
Chapter 30 Montgomery GI Bill	Certificate of Eligibility	Student pays tuition out of pocket or uses financial aid VA may provide a monthly stipend if eligible
Chapter 31 Veteran Readiness & Employment	Purchase Order from your VA Education Services Officer (ESO) through Tungsten	Unity receives tuition funds directly from the VA VA may provide a monthly stipend if eligible Student works with their VA ESO Request your Evaluated Degree Plan
Chapter 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill	Certificate of Eligibility <i>or</i> Statement of Benefits and Military Service	Unity receives tuition funds directly from the VA Student pays out of pocket or uses financial aid for any remaining costs not covered by benefits
Chapter 35 Dependent's Educational Assistance	Certificate of Eligibility Student's SSN	Student pays tuition out of pocket or uses financial aid VA reimburses the student via a monthly stipend for tuition and other eligible expenses
Chapter 1606 Selected Reserve	Notice of Basic Eligibility	Student pays tuition out of pocket or uses financial aid VA may provide a monthly stipend if eligible
Military Tuition Assistance (TA)	Approved voucher from your military branch of service	TA pays \$250 per credit Student is responsible for remaining balance
